## TRANSFORM

### Your Story – The 5<sup>th</sup> Gospel.

**BIG IDEA:** Our response to the Gospel must be the same but our lives in response to the Gospel will be unique.

#### ICE BREAKER:

1. As a human being, what are some things that everyone in your group has in common?
2. As an individual, what are some things about your life that are unique only to you?

#### THINK:

1. What is the Gospel?
2. How did you respond to the Gospel?
3. What is one *unique* way your life has been changed because of *your* response to the Gospel? THINK!

#### EXAMINE:

1. Consider the four Gospels in the New Testament.
  - What is the same about each author and their Gospel?
  - What is unique about each author and their Gospel?
  - What is your favorite Gospel? Why?
  - Why do you think God gave us four Gospels instead of just one?
2. Consider your story as the 5<sup>th</sup> Gospel.
  - What would be in the first chapter of your story? (Clue...how do the other Gospel writers begin?)
  - What are some of your favorite stories about Jesus that you would want to make sure and include?
  - What are some of your encounters with Jesus that you would include? i.e. Zacchaeus
  - What are some moments of great victory that you would include? i.e. Peter walking on the water.
  - What are some moments of weak faith that you would include? i.e. Peter sinking in the water.
  - How would you incorporate the theme of God's grace into your Gospel story?

**THIS WEEK:** Remember the secret...*Christ in you, the hope of glory.* (**Colossians 1:27**) You are not just imitating Christ but you are dwelling with Him as His disciple. You and Christ must be inseparable! As His follower, where is He leading you this week? What does He want you to experience this week so that your faith in Him might grow? Write a paragraph in your Gospel this week that you will share with your group next week. Who needs to hear your Gospel story so they can begin their own Gospel...GOOD NEWS story?
